The Hong Kong PhD Fellowship Scheme (HKPFS) offers:

- a monthly stipend of HK\$26,900 (~US\$3,450) for 3 years; and
- a yearly allowance of HK\$13,500 (~US\$1,730) for conference and research-related travel for 3 years

In addition to the above package, PolyU offers:

- tuition waiver scholarship for the entire normal study period
- the 4th year stipend with the same provision, if required;
- cash award of HK\$40,000 (~US\$5,120) in the 1st year, and HK\$20,000 (~US\$2,560) from the 2nd year to end of normal study period; and
- · guaranteed hall accommodation for 2 years.

Once the applicants are nominated by PolyU to RGC as candidates for HKPFS, they are accepted as PhD students with an attractive package from:

Admission Requirements

1. Academic qualification

HKPFS candidates should possess:

- an MPhil or a research postgraduate degree with a dissertation as an award requirement, conferred by a recognised university (for 3-year PhD programmes); or
- a Bachelor's degree with First Class Honours, or a Master's degree, conferred by a recognised university (for 4-year PhD programmes).

2. English proficiency requirement

- Exempted for candidates who have obtained a degree awarded by institutions where the medium of instruction was English; or
- TOEFL ≥ 80 for internet-based test; or
- TOEFL ≥ 550 for paper-based test.
- All English language test scores are considered valid for two years after the date of the test.

3. Others

 HKPFS candidates should also possess the following attributes: cultural diversity, leadership ability, societal responsibility, communication and interpersonal skills.
